MISSION



Since 2005, 600 disadvantaged youth have received a top-quality, values-based education thanks to ACCESS Academies' unique model of education.

ACCESS (Academies Creating Challenging Education for St. Louis Students) makes a seven-year commitment to each student, beginning in middle school, to support a robust academic curriculum, homework assistance, service projects and enrichment. ACCESS also supports mandatory summer school, and provides a school-based Graduate Support Director, who works directly with each student, and their family, from middle school, through high school, and into college.

During the 2015-16 school year, over 135 middle school students were enrolled in Academies within three Archdiocesan partner schools:

- Most Holy Trinity School & Academy at 1435 Mallinckrodt St. (North St. Louis)
- St. Cecilia School & Academy at 906 Eichelberger (South St. Louis)
- St. Louis the King School at the Cathedral at 4430 Maryland Ave. (Central West End)

In addition, over 200 Academy graduates received high school tuition scholarships and/or guidance from ACCESS's Graduate Support Directors during the 2015-16 school year.

We have opened Academies at these parish schools and extended the school day and year to provide the education and support services needed to not only get accepted to private, college-preparatory high schools, but to excel in them. Once there, we doubled our efforts to monitor their social and academic growth, and, if necessary, stepped in to ensure that these students were on the pathway to college.

Our mission has not changed, and we are deeply proud of all that we and our students have accomplished. However, the number of students in poverty continues to grow, and we are mindful of the educational challenges in our community that must be addressed.

To meet those challenges, we remain committed and responsible stewards of the financial resources with which we have been entrusted. This report is intended to give you a clear and accurate picture of our ongoing efforts to carry out that stewardship.

It is an honor to do this work, and I extend my deepest thanks for your support.
